Recreation Board Chairman Dale Light called the Recreation Board meeting to order at 7:04 p.m. at the Bethel Township Office 60 Klahr Road Bethel, PA.

Roll Call- Members in attendance were Dale Light, Don Almond, Bonnie Behney, and Township Supervisor Michael Graby. Absent was member Darlene Orendo.

Unfinished Business-

1. Recreation Land Update-

- a. The Recreation Board met with Gary Kraft on July 17, 2017 at 6 p.m. at the Airport Road property to discuss the placement of the driveway and parking lot area.
- b. Don Almond made a motion seconded by Bonnie Behney to request that the Bethel Township Board of Supervisors approve a Boundary Survey and Topographic Survey 350-400 feet back along the road frontage of the Airport Road property to better determine the parking lot and driveway placement.
- c. Fred Folmer represented EAC and offered their assistance with any part of the project as needed.

2. Frystown Playground Update-

- a. The Recreation Board is still waiting for the DCNR grant announcements.

- b. The outhouse building has been removed, holes filled in, and cemented. Don Almond will have the bike rack installed.
- c. "Donations to the Playground" sign is completed and needs to be mounted.
- d. Recognition Event- the Recreation Board has set a date of September 24, 2017 at 1:00pm rain date October 1, 2017 at 1:00 p.m. to recognize donations to the Frystown playground and Hometown Hero Banners pending supervisor approval. Mike Graby will present the event for approval at the next supervisor's meeting.
- e. The menu for event will be discussed and finalized at the August meeting. The event program will also be discussed.

3. Hometown Hero Banners-

- a. Due to popular demand the Recreation Board will offer a second round of Hometown Hero Banners. Orders will be due July 31, 2017 with installation to occur before the recognition event. The board advertised in the local merchandiser. Bonnie reported giving out information to 8 different families.
