

**BETHEL TOWNSHIP  
AGRICULTURAL SECURITY AREA  
PUBLIC HEARING**

March 19, 2018

The Bethel Township Board of Supervisors Agricultural Security Area Public Hearing was called to order by Chairman Jacob C Meyer at 6:48 p.m. in the Bethel Township Meeting Room, Bethel, PA.

In attendance for the public hearing were Supervisors Jacob Meyer, Lee Groff and Mike Graby. Also, in attendance were Solicitor Eugene Orlando Jr. and Township Sec. Treas. Jayne Seifrit.

Jacob Meyer turned the hearing over to Solicitor Eugene Orlando. He stated the hearing is for additions to the Bethel Township Agriculture Security Area and the 7-year review. Eugene Orlando entered several items as Board Exhibits; B1 proof of publication, B2 the certification of posting the property, B3 certification of mailing to participants already enrolled in the program, B4 letter from Bethel Township to Berks County Planning Commission and the response letter from Berks County Planning Commission, B5 letter dated February 20, 2018 from Agriculture Security Advisory Council recommending the additions, B6 minutes from the Bethel Township Planning Commission stating they reviewed and recommend the additions, B7 application of Jeffrey L Brown for the 16.93 acres and B8 application of Jeremy and Cindy Martin 1261 Little Mountain Rd 49.45 acres. The Bethel Township Planning Commission and the Bethel Township Agriculture Security Advisory Board reviewed existing area as part of the 7-year review. There were not any changes requested as part of the 7-year review. Eugene Orlando asked if there were any comments from the public. There were not any comments from the public. Eugene Orlando stated the Board intends to take action at a meeting following the hearing.
