

**BETHEL TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
MINUTES
March 27, 2017**

The Bethel Township Board of Supervisors meeting was called to order by Chairman Jacob Meyer at 7:56 p.m. in the Bethel Township Meeting Room, Bethel PA.

9555 Old Route 22 – Robin Royer stated she received notice of the hearing to take place in April.

Mike Graby made a motion to approve recommendation from Planning Commission to waive Section 4.02.C.3.b to allow the utility information not to be shown on plan, seconded by Jake Meyer. All agreed. Motion carried. Mike Graby made a motion to approve recommendation from Planning Commission to waive Section

4.02.C.3.d to not show topographic information on plan, seconded by Lee Groff. All agreed. Motion carried. Jake Meyer made a motion to approve recommendation from Planning Commission to waive Section 4.02.C.3.e to not show soil mapping on plan, seconded by Mike Graby. All agreed. Motion carried. Lee Groff made a motion to approve recommendation from Planning Commission to approve a partial waiver of Section 5.12 to not require property corners to be set at frontage Route 501 and the Alley, seconded by Mike Graby. All agreed. Motion carried. Jake Meyer made a motion to approve final plan contingent on all items from the Kraft Engineering review letter dated March 26, 2018 being met, seconded by Mike Graby. All agreed. Motion carried.
