

**BETHEL TOWNSHIP
BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, PLANNING COMMISSION
AND TRANSPORTATION IMPACT FEE ADVISORY COMMITTEE
MINUTES**

May 22, 2018

The workshop meeting was convened and members introduced themselves. In attendance were members; George Shollenberger, Betsy Bowman, Bill Straw, Michael Orendo, Corey Houser, Brian Bauer, Lisa Hassler, Jessica Matarazzi-Houser and Dale Stump. Board of Supervisors in attendance were Jacob Meyer and Lee Groff. Solicitor, Eugene Orlando, Engineer, Gary Kraft and Sec Treas. Jayne Seifrit also attended the meeting held in the Meeting Room located at 60 Klahr Rd, Bethel PA.

Jodie Evans, P.E. PTOE, McMahon Transportation Engineer & Planners, handed out several items for the committee to discuss and consider. Jodie Evans presented an overview of what the fees can be used for and what they cannot be used for. Jodie Evans stated the three components that make up Act 209 Transportation Impact Fees; those being the Land Use Assumption report, Roadway Sufficiency Analysis and the Transportation Capital Improvement Plan. She gave examples of scenarios to further explain some of the terms used. Jodie Evans provided a list of intersections from the current TIF and also a map that shows level of service, some in bold blue circles and some in dotted blue circles and some without any special mark. The bold blue intersections, she is presenting as intersections that might be eliminated, blue dotted intersections to be studied or not and the intersections without any marks are the ones that were identified last time as needing to be studied. The idea is if any can be eliminated then a new intersection could be studied. The cost of this process is partially based on the number of intersections to be studied.

A quick look resulted in keeping intersections 645 and Daub Rd, Airport Rd and 501, and Airport Rd and Old Route 22. Two intersections to be added are Central Blvd and 645 and Martha Drive and 501. Also, Central Blvd and Martha Drive need to be placed on schematic. The members are tasked with looking at the sheets and seeing if there are any others to be added, deleted or stay as they are.

Next meeting is scheduled for June 26, 2018 at 6:00 pm.
