Unfinished Business -

1. Airport Road Project.-
Several discussions:
 - a. Run electric to pavilion. Dusk to dawn light. Receptacles on wall.
 - b. Do we need to dig well for water? Water grass if needed. Washing.
 - c. Build equipment shed now or at a later date.
 - d. Make sure everything is included in Bid Request including a step by step list of items to be completed. Hopefully Engineer will guide some decisions.
 - e. 36'x48' Metal roof, metal ceiling, vinyl covered poles. Low maintenance as much as possible. Stained wood looks great but too much future maintenance.
 - f. Tot-lot playground placement.
 - g. Looked over quote from 2020 for pavilion.
 - h. Work day April 17, 2021, later changed to April 10, 2021, 7:30 a.m.
Small stumps should be removed to make walking path better.
Discussion on purchasing or renting a stump grinder. Mr. Hassler said he thought Zimmerman's had one to rent. Later he said they sold it. He said maybe Fisher's in Bernville rented them. Dale said a skid loader could do the job also.
2. Public Works Department work request list for 2021 was approved. A copy was given to Jacob Meyer.
3. Frystown Playground. -
 - a. Viking Baseball Club Vice-President said a copy of insurance policy will be emailed to Jayne.
 - b. Still getting quotes for fencing. One was \$35,000.00
Little League regulations will be used. 8' at some spots dropping down to 4'.
