

ORDINANCE NO. 1962 - 2

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF BETHEL, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, OPENING AS A PUBLIC TOWNSHIP ROAD FOR PUBLIC USE AND TRAVEL MARKET STREET FROM CROSS STREET NORTHWARDLY A TOTAL DISTANCE OF 828 FEET, SAID STREET BEING LOCATED IN THE VILLAGE OF BETHEL.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, by the Board of Supervisors of Bethel Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and IT IS HEREBY ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the same as follows:

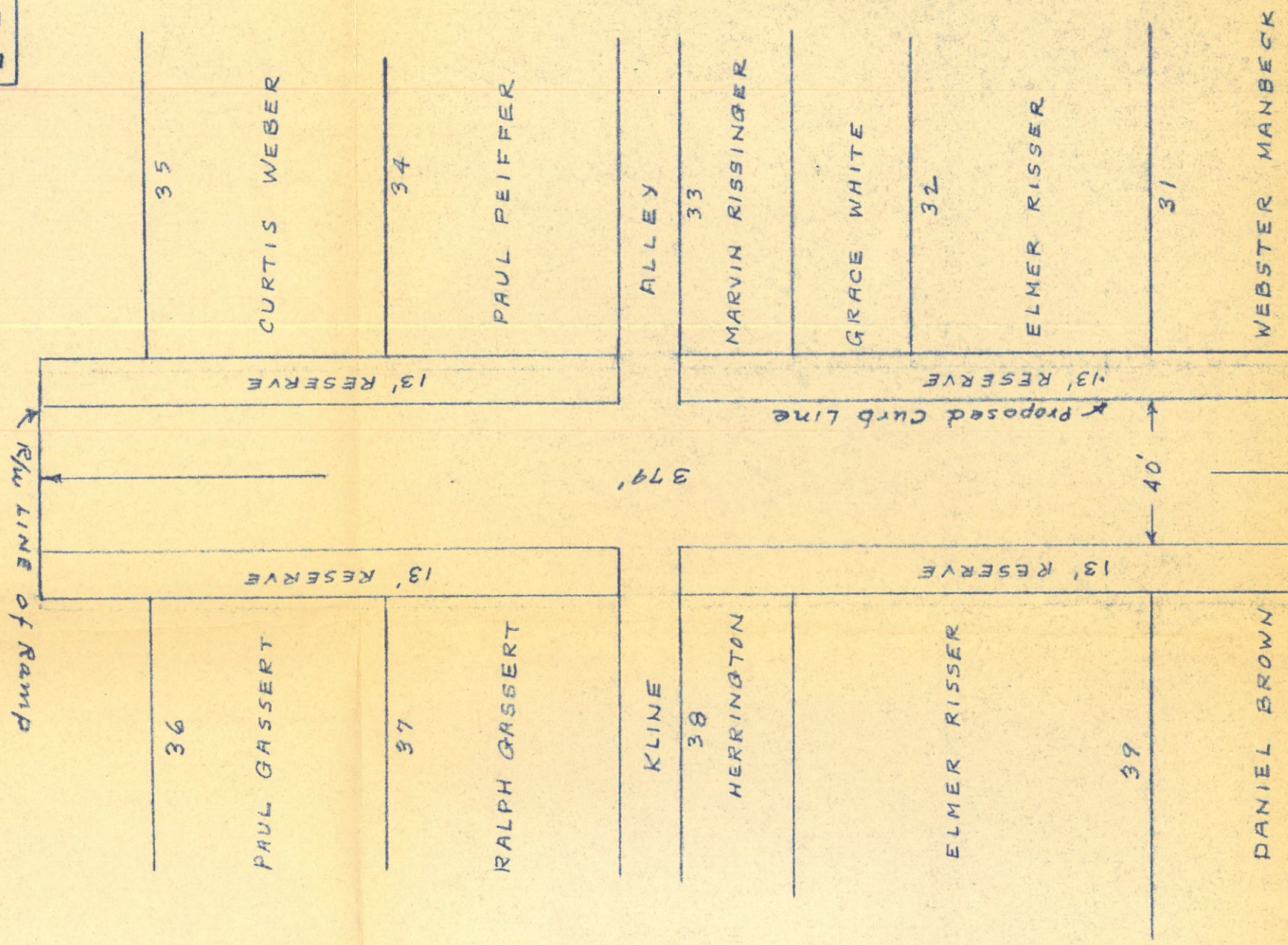
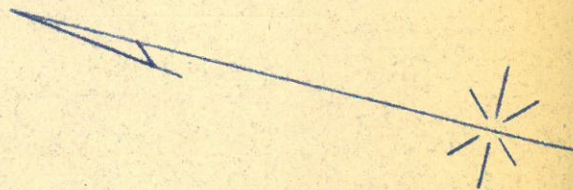
SECTION 1 - That Market Street in the Village of Bethel from the northerly side of Cross Street northward for a distance of 828 feet and more fully described as follows, to wit:

BEGINNING at the North edge of a concrete road in the town of Bethel known as Cross Street, thence Northwardly two hundred twenty-three (223) feet with a width of ninety-four (94) feet from curb to curb (said curb line being a proposed line) to the North side of Blackberry Alley; thence Northwardly two hundred twenty-six (226) feet with a width of sixty-one (61) feet curb to curb, to the North side of Chestnut Street; thence Northwardly three hundred seventy-nine (379) feet, with a width of forty (40) feet curb to curb, to the right-of-way line of a ramp leading to U. S. Route #22,

be opened and ordained as a public township road to the widths as set forth in the above description.

SECTION 2 - That a Plan of that portion of Market Street hereinabove described in Section 1 be attached hereto, made a part hereof, and be on file at the Office of the Secretary of the Board of Supervisors of Bethel Township.
