

AN ORDINANCE laying out, opening and adopting a public street in the Township of Bethel, a street to be designated as Township Route 692 Extended and fixing and regulating the width and length thereof.

The Township of Bethel hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I. The following street, which is hereby designated as Township Route 692 Extended, is hereby laid out, opened and ordained as a public street in the Township of Bethel:

ALL THAT CERTAIN street known as Township Route 692 Extended, being 33 feet wide, beginning at the northern end of the present Township Route 692 (which Township Route 692 intersects Legislative Route 06006 at its southern end) and extending northerly therefrom a distance of .2 of a mile.

SECTION II. The Secretary of the Township of Bethel shall cause the within ordinance to be recorded in the Ordinance Book of the Township of Bethel and a certified copy of the within ordinance, together with a survey of the aforesaid street, shall be filed in the Office of the Clerk of Quarter Sessions of the County of Berks in the Court House in Reading, Berks County, Pennsylvania.

SECTION III. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.
