

**ORDINANCE NO. 2014-05**

**AN ORDINANCE OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 2005-07, REGARDING THE BETHEL TOWNSHIP RECREATION BOARD BY DELETING TERM LIMITS PROVIDED IN THAT ORDINANCE.**

WHEREAS, Bethel Township, Berks County, PA (The Township) adopted Ordinance 2005-07 on November 14, 2005; and,

WHEREAS, Section 2 entitled "Board Membership and Function" creates a limitation on service by Board Members to two consecutive terms; and,

WHEREAS, the Township believes it is in the interest of the citizens and residents of the Township to retain experienced and qualified Recreation Board Members.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Supervisors of Bethel Township hereby ENACTS and ORDAINS as follows:

Section 1. Amendment to Eliminate Term Limits.

Bethel Township Ordinance 2005-07, Section 2 entitled "Board Membership and Function" is hereby amended by deleting the second sentence thereof which sentence limits service by members to two full consecutive terms. It is the intent of this Ordinance to eliminate term limits for service on the Recreation Board.

Section 2. Ratification and Repeals.

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar, but only insofar, as the same are inconsistent herewith.

Section 3. Severability.

The provisions of this Ordinance are severable and if any provision or part thereof shall be held invalid, unconstitutional or inapplicable to any person or circumstances, such invalidity, unconstitutionality or inapplicability shall not effect or impair the remaining provisions or parts thereof of this Ordinance.


Section 4. Effective Date.


This Ordinance shall become effective five days after its adoption.
