

TOWNSHIP OF BETHEL
ORDINANCE NO. 1967-3

AN ORDINANCE laying out, opening and adopting as public streets (commonly known as alleys) in the Village of Frystown, Township of Bethel, certain streets (commonly known as alleys) and fixing and regulating the width and length thereof.

The Township of Bethel hereby ordains as follows:

SECTION I. The following streets, commonly known as alleys, named and designated as herein set forth, are hereby laid out, opened and ordained as public streets (alleys) in the Village of Frystown, Township of Bethel:

ROSE ALLEY having a width of sixteen and five-tenths (16.5) feet and extending from the South right-of-way line of Legislative Route 06003 four hundred fifteen (415) feet to the North side of Chestnut Street; bounded on the East by land of Westenberger and on the West by lands of Edwin Musser and Mary Weaver.

LONG ALLEY having a width of sixteen and five-tenths (16.5) feet and extending from the West side of Rose Alley Westward one hundred thirty-two (132) feet; bounded on the North by lots of Mary Weaver and Edwin Musser and on the South by lot of Mary Weaver.

CHESTNUT STREET having a width of thirty-three (33) feet and extending from the West side of Rose Alley six hundred (600) feet to the East side of Race Street; bounded on the North by lots of George Snyder, Lions Club Playground, David Kurtz and Mary Weaver; and on the South by lots of The Dunkard Brethren Church, the Lions Playground and Roy Spannuth, Jr.

LONG ALLEY having a width of sixteen and five-tenths (16.5) feet and extending from the West side of Race Street Westward one hundred ninety-seven (197) feet; bounded on the North by lots of Henry F. Keeney, Earl Marks, Howard Ziegler and Richard Moyer; and on the South by lots of Earl Marks.

hundred eight (208) feet to the North side of Strawberry Alley; bounded on the West by lot of Forrest Marks and on the East by lot of Angelo Melito.

STRAWBERRY ALLEY having a width of sixteen and five-tenths (16.5) feet and extending from the East side of Race Street Eastward five hundred sixteen (516) feet; bounded on the North by land of Curtis Swope and Clarence Spannuth and on the South by town lots.

STRAWBERRY ALLEY having a width of sixteen and five-tenths (16.5) feet and extending from the East right-of-way line of Cumberland Street Eastward two hundred ten (210) feet; bounded on the North by land of the Frystown Fire Company and on the South by lots of Lizzie Diffenbach and Warren Strickler.

STRAWBERRY ALLEY having a width of sixteen and five-tenths (16.5) feet and extending from the West right-of-way line of Cumberland Street Westward five hundred sixty-five (565) feet to the East side of Wax Alley; bounded on the North by land of John Henninger and on the South by town lots.

WAX ALLEY having a width of sixteen and five-tenths (16.5) feet and extending from the North side of Strawberry Alley Southward two hundred twenty-three (223) feet to the North right-of-way line of Legislative Route 06003; bounded on the West by lot of Stone Bar Inn and on the East by lot of Harry Weidner.

LONG ALLEY having a width of sixteen and five-tenths (16.5) feet and extending from the East side of Township Road 660 Eastward four hundred two (402) feet to the West side of Cumberland Street; bounded on the North by lots of Mertin Frantz, Ray Ritchie and John Wolf and on the South by land of Ralph Zerby.

SECTION II. The Secretary of the Township of Bethel

shall cause the within Ordinance to be recorded in the Ordinance

Book of the Township of Bethel and a certified copy of the within

Ordinance, together with a survey of the aforesaid streets (alleys), shall be filed in the Office of the Clerk of Quarter Sessions of

Pennsylvania.

SECTION III. All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance be and the same are hereby repealed.

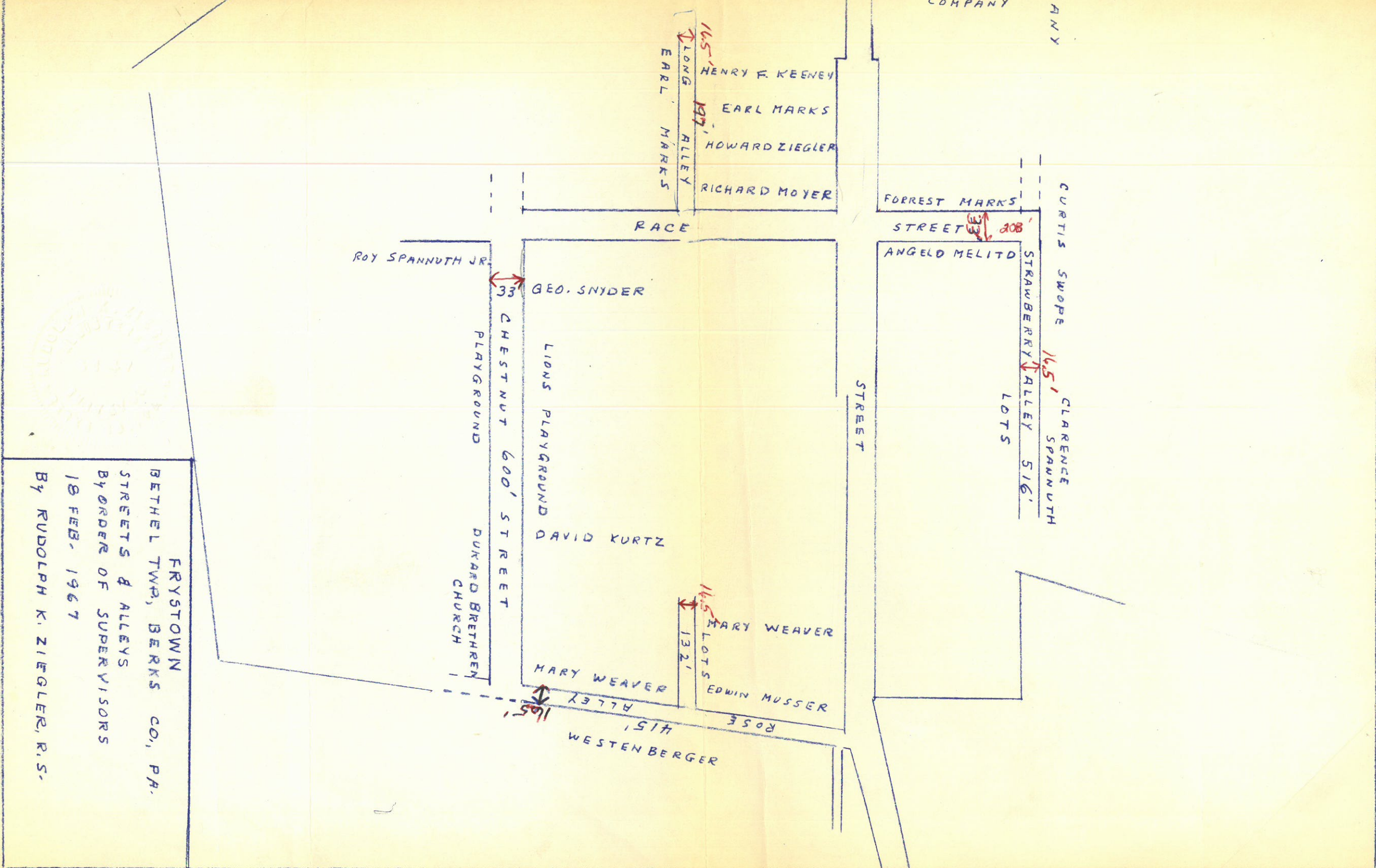
