TOWNSHIP OF BETHEL
ORDINANCE NO. 1972 - /

AN ORDINANCE of the Township of Bethel, Berks County, creating a Township Planning Commission pursuant to Act No. 247, known as the Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code, providing for the appointment of seven (7) members to serve on such Planning Commission and conferring upon said Commission all the powers and duties conferred by the said Act No. 247, known and identified as Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of Bethel, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as follows:

SECTION I. A Township Planning Commission consisting of seven (7) members is hereby created and established as provided in Act No. 247 approved the 31st day of July, A.D. 1968, effective January 1, 1969, known as the "Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code".

SECTION II. The seven (7) members of the Planning Commission hereby created and established shall be appointed by the Supervisors of the Township of Bethel in accordance with the provisions of said Act No. 247 hereinabove cited.

SECTION III. All of the members of the Planning Commission shall be residents of the Township of Bethel and at least five (5) of the members of the Planning Commission designated as citizen members shall not be officers or employees of the Township of Bethel as provided by the terms of Act No. 247 hereinabove cited.

SECTION IV. All of the powers and duties conferred on planning commissions or planning agencies by said Act No. 247 hereinabove cited and known as the "Pennsylvania Municipalities Planning Code" and any amendments and supplements thereto, together with any

provisions of the Second Class Township Code where the same are not
Inconsistent or in conflict with the provisions of said Act No. 247,
are hereby conferred and imposed on said Township Planning Commission
as herein created and established.

SECTION V. Ordinance No. 1970 - 1 of the Township of
Bethel enacted May 5, 1970, is hereby repealed. All other ordinances,
resolutions or parts of ordinances or resolutions that are inconsis-
tent herewith are hereby repealed.
