

ORDINANCE NO. 1991-1

AN ORDINANCE OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING A STOP INTERSECTION AT THE INTERSECTION OF NORTH FAUST ROAD AND CLUB ROAD

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of Bethel Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1: The following intersection is established as a stop intersection, and an official stop sign shall be erected in such a position as to face traffic approaching the second-named street (the intersecting or through street) on the first-named street (the stop street) in the direction indicated for that intersection. Every driver of a vehicle approaching the intersection on the first-named or stop street, in the direction indicated for that street, shall stop the vehicle as required by Section 3323(b) of the Vehicle Code of Pennsylvania, and shall not proceed into the second-named or intersecting or through street until he or she has followed all applicable requirements of that section of the law.

1. Club Road	North Faust Road	West bound

SECTION 2: Any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction in a summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine of Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) and costs.

SECTION 3: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This Ordinance shall take effect when an official stop sign has been erected in accordance with Section 1 hereof, or five (5) days after enactment, whichever occurs later.
