

ORDINANCE NO. 1992- /

AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF BETHEL TOWNSHIP, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, AMENDING THE BETHEL TOWNSHIP ZONING ORDINANCE OF 1977, AS AMENDED, TO ADD AN EXEMPTION TO THE PERMIT REQUIREMENTS OF THE SIGN REGULATIONS

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the authority of the Board of Supervisors of Bethel Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. Section 1029.06 of the Bethel Township Zoning Ordinance of 1977, Ordinance No. 1977-1, enacted July 20, 1977, as added by Ordinance No. 1990-1, enacted January 15, 1990, is hereby amended by adding the heading - Exemptions - and by adding the following clause to Subsection a. thereof:

(5) Temporary signs that will not be in place for longer than six months in a twelve-month period and meet all other requirements of the ordinance for the district in which they are located.

SECTION 2. All ordinances of parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3. In all other respects, the said Bethel Township Zoning Ordinance of 1977, as previously amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after enactment, as provided by law.
